Rules and Conditions of Entry

Every Team Member must read the following! –

- ✦ All films must be made in the 24-hour period as designated by organisers.
- ✦ All films must be no more than 7 minutes in length, including all Intro and credits. (Yes that means NOT 7.01 minutes!)
- ✦ All films must incorporate at least 5 of the items detailed on the official list of 12 items, including at least 1 from each category, and all must include the Secret Rule.
- ✦ All participants must be between 12 and 24 years old on the day of the competition.
- ✦ Team Age Categories are calculated on the average age of members on the day of the competition.
- ✦ All participants must agree to and sign a 24/7 Youth Film Festival Indemnity Form and read the **Rules and Conditions**.
- ✦ All participants must adhere to the instructions of 24/7 Staff, Supervisors, Tutors and Volunteers.
- ✦ All films must be viewable by a public audience. Any films deemed offensive by Judges/organisers will be removed from the competition, or may be required to be modified (M Rating or less - for details contact the Australian Bureau of Classification).
- ✦ Any film teams partaking in unlawful, irresponsible, dangerous or anti-social behaviour or stunts (including 'Jackass' style films) will be immediately disqualified and organisers take no responsibility for their actions, damages or consequences.
- ✦ The only music films can contain must either be taken from the 24/7 CD library, from bands/individuals having approved use of their material for 24/7 or be music that the film team holds the copyright for.
- ✦ The filmmakers must have the permission of all actors/extras featuring in any film.
- ✦ Only entered team members can be directly involved in the making of your film.
- ✦ By entering a film in 24/7 you are giving permission for your work to feature in any way, shape or form, as part of any 24/7 related or other event, in its entirety or in edited format.
- ✦ Films are permitted to use superimposed text and animation.
- ✦ The decisions of the judges will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.

NEW RULES - due to laws around firearm usage and the heightened state of security and police advice, the following rules apply -

- ✦ No guns or firearms, including replicas or toys, are permitted to be used in the films, either indoor or outdoors. (If police receive reports of people running around the local park with 'guns' they are obliged to automatically call in the SWAT Team!)
 - ✦ Stay away from major security zones, political or infrastructure sites – Examples –
 - The City
 - North Sydney, including Kirribilli House and the Harbour Bridge
 - Other major bridges & infrastructure
 - Army and naval bases including; North Head Army Barracks, Balmoral Naval Base, South Creek Rd Army Reserve Depot
 - Belrose Communications Centre – the one with all the big satellite dishes.
 - All Power Sub-Stations, sewerage works, etc.
- If in doubt – contact your local police station and let them know you will be filming in a certain area.

A SECRET RULE will be announced at the launch and must appear in every film being entered!
